

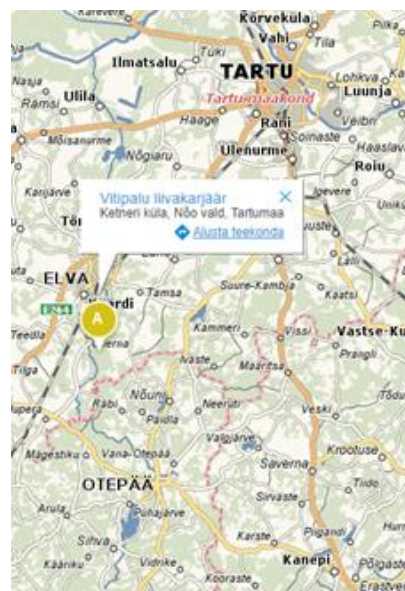
Event Centre
